Product Eligibility

- Equipment purchased more than 90 days prior to application or date of contractor invoice is not eligible.
- Upgrade must be completed within 90 days of application.
- Must comply with District electric service requirements. Contact Work Orders at 1.530.582.3931 or email newconstruction@tdpud.org for more information.
- Only new main panels qualify for incentive (used panels are not refurbished).
- New panel must be a minimum of 200 amps and have a rated load greater than the previous panel (Exception: upgrading to a smart panel of equivalent or greater rated load).
- Upgrade must include dedicated circuit for at least (2) of the following: EV Charger, Heat Pump Water Heater, Heat Pump (HVAC), or combined Solar PV and battery storage.
- Upgrade must have at least one of the listed electrification measures installed at time of rebate application.
- Project must be permitted through Town of Truckee Building department. Call 1.530.582.7821 for more details.

Program Terms

- Applicant must be a current electric customer with an active TDPUD account to be eligible for electric rebates.
- Application must include detailed and dated sales receipt(s), manufacturer/model number of eligible product(s) or service(s) clearly identified, including contractor's name.
- Rebates are issued to the account holder in the form of a one-time check payment. Payments are typically processed within 6-8 weeks of TDPUD receiving the main panel rebate application.
- If account holder is a landlord and account is inactive at the time of rebate issuance, a check will be mailed to the landlord address on file.
- Rebate not to exceed the cost of equipment and installation.
- Photo of old panel, prior to start of upgrade must be provided.
- Photo(s) of new installed panel must be provided.
- Photo/copy of permits must be provided.
- Application must be signed, dated, and contain all supporting documentation.

TDPUD disclaims all liability from taxes incurred or any property damage or loss that may arise as a result of the applicant's participation in this program. The rebate offer may be discontinued or modified at any time by TDPUD. Applicant certifies that the above noted appliances(s) and/or equipment will be installed at the TDPUD service address identified on this application.
