These symbols identify each plant's properties on the markers throughout the Conservation Garden.

BUNCH GRASS = SAVE WATER

The native bunch grass meadow uses only a fraction of the water of a traditional grass lawn. The meadow is divided into three types of bunch grasses:

- 1 Turf Fescue:** a traditional lawn substitute that uses 1/3 of the water needed for a traditional grass lawn.
- 2 3-Type Blend Fescue:** a low-maintenance, no-mow alternative.
- 3 Native Meadow Barley & Wildflower Mix:** perfect for large area meadow restorations.
