BINGO BOARD KEY

B1	Turn water off while brushing your teeth
B2	Wash clothes in cold water
В3	Reduce furnace/heater energy by using fans to move hot air from the ceiling down to your level
B4	Always use a hose with shut-off valve installed for outdoor watering
B5	Replace old energy hogs with new high efficiency appliances. Check out our website for rebates!
I1	Turn off lights when not in use or when there is enough natural light from windows
12	Set back your thermostat 2 or more degrees from normal — down for heating or up for cooling
13	Replace your landscaping with drought resistant trees & bushes or hardscape
14	Clean out your fridge. Too much food piled high can hinder efficient distribution of cool air
15	Use water-wise plants, check with your local garden stores
N1	Use a broom to clean outdoor areas instead of hosing it off
N2	Use mulch in your yard to keep water trapped in material
N4	Use a shower time to monitor and limit time spent in shower, try a 5 minute shower
N5	Install a low-flow showerhead
G 1	Air-dry laundry instead of using your dryer
G2	Turn water off while shaving
G3	Turn off phantom power loads (e.g. TVs, computers, chargers, etc) when not in use
G4	Hand wash dishes in a basin, do not leave the water running down the sink
G5	Close blinds on south and western aspects of your home in summer to keep heat out
01	Change your furnace air filter every 90 days. Clean filters use less energy and clean your air
02	Turn off your oven a few minutes before you finish cooking. The residual heat will finish it!
О3	Use automatic timers for your irrigation system
04	Reheat food in the microwave instead of the stove. Microwave uses much less energy
05	Unplug your electronics, park your car, and do one extra activity outside in your neighborhood
